

CASS Leadership Excellence: Sharing Stories of Practice During COVID-19

Description

Organizational stories about our problems of practice have a compelling ability to communicate information, convey beliefs, and share lessons learned. When system leaders share their stories of practice with one another, they become involved in the co-construction of meaning that amplifies the efficacy of their leadership. In this session, Scott Morrison will share a Covid 19 story of practice followed by a short debrief on the story using themes from the literature. Participants will then have the opportunity to informally share their own stories in facilitated small group discussions.
